Situation:

The 3458A utilizes the subroutine "SUB 0" as an autostart routine. This sub-program is automatically executed by the 3458A during its' "power-on sequence" or when a front panel "RESET" command is executed. All subroutines are stored in non-volatile memory and remain in memory when power is removed from the 3458A. Subroutines are covered in more detail in the 3458A User's Guide (Chapter 3; section titled "Using Subprogram Memory").

If a user stores a subroutine as "SUB 0" the meter will power-up according to the commands in this routine. This can lead to unexpected turn-on configurations. This unexpected turn-on configuration will occur each time power is cycled or when a front panel "RESET" command is given. This situation is often misinterpreted as a 3458A failure.

Solution/Action:

Any stored autostart subroutine can be "erased" using one of the following commands from the 3458A front panel or from a controller connected to the 3458A:

"DELSUB 0" ---- (This command will only erase the autostart subroutine)

"SCRATCH" ---- (This command will erase all user stores subroutines and any stored states)

Note: Following the execution of either of the above commands; the instrument will utilize the "default" states when power is cycled or a front panel "RESET" command is issued.
